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The Lawyers' Committee is excited to announce the launch of the Parental Readiness and Empowerment Program's (PREP) e-clinic on **September 6th** for parents in **California**! Building upon the success of PREP's digital platform, parents will meet virtually via video chat with a pro bono advocate to discuss educational issues related to special education, school discipline or English Language Learners. Volunteers and parents will work together in an online setting to formulate an action plan that will support addressing their child's educational success.

Over the past five years, PREP has served over 4,000 parents, providing over 50 workshops in multiple languages, hosting 8 webinars in English and Spanish, posting 30 video tutorials, and training 170 pro bono volunteers. With targeted resources for underrepresented families, special education students, and English Language Learners, PREP prides itself on working to build a country where educational equity is a reality for all children. With the launch of our e-clinic, we hope to empower even more parents to advocate for their children!


